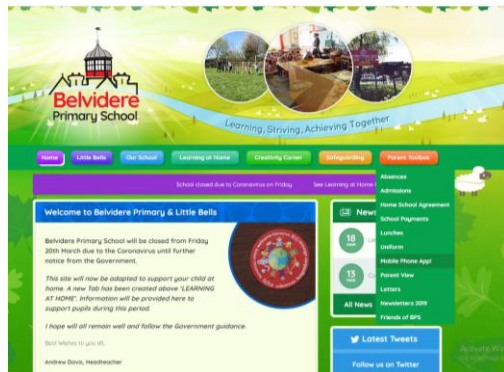

As you are no doubt aware, all schools in England will be closed from Monday 23rd March until further notice.

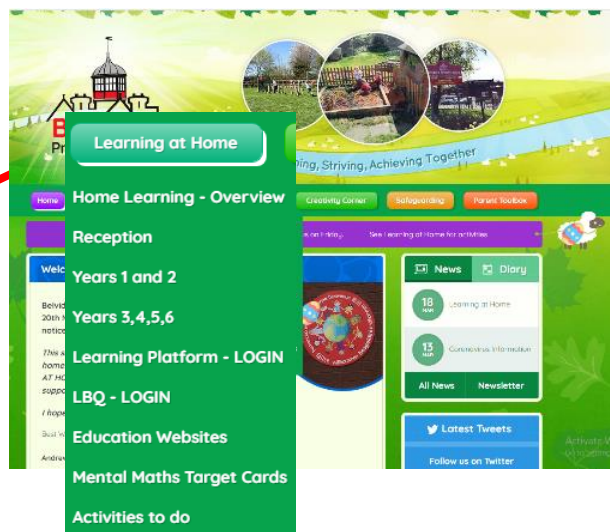
Please ensure you have downloaded the School APP-instructions for how to do this are on the website under the 'parents toolbar' section:

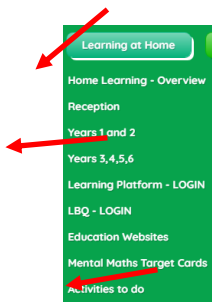


During the children's absence from school, there are a variety of activities, both academic and non-academic that they can do.

We are therefore also providing activities online and suggestions for other experiences the children could be given within the family home.

The Year group pages offer specific information and links for the key stage. In Key stage 1 there are links to specific classes, while in Key stage 2, daily activities linked to LBQ and the learning platform will be posted on the class pages.

The 'Activities to do' section provides ideas for other activities that support their learning and promote key life skills.

You will also be aware that the Government has declared that some schools will be open for children of key workers and children who are deemed vulnerable. As a school we have no further information regarding how or where this provision will take place. Please be assured however that we will inform you as soon as we know. Proof of occupation will be required from parents.
